If you are interested in doing something interactive with your booth, some initial ideas of what this could look like are:

- An activity for students to engage in like learning about nutrition through a food sorting activity, games, etc.
- A sample demo of some of the services that you provide (like sample blood pressure tests if you are a health organization)
- Sign up on the spot for services you may provide
- Taking pictures, creating something, or making something (ie: teacher education booth, asking adults and kids to write the name of their favorite teacher and why and post it somewhere)

The options are very flexible and we can work together to help make your booth come together. We are also more than willing to meet/talk if you'd like to think of some activities we could help your booth provide!
