First Two Weeks of School: Schedule and Procedures

Konawaena High Parents and Guardians

Here is hoping all is well with everyone and that we are each doing our part to stay safe and healthy! As we get closer to the first day of school and plans develop, we are doing our best to keep everyone updated. This letter is to inform you of the schedule for the first two weeks of school and some of the screening procedures being put into place.

As a reminder, students have been divided into two groups by last names. They attend school only on the days their group is assigned. Deviations from assigned days may only be arranged on a case-by-case basis.

Group A – last names A-Ka

Group B – last names Ke-Z

The school day begins at 8:15am and for the first two weeks will end at 11:45am. The cafeteria will be serving breakfast and lunch (wiki).

To assist with safe practice requirements, please do your best not to drop off your child earlier than 7:30. We appreciate your understanding.

The schedule for the first two weeks is as follows:

	Tues, August 4 9th grade only Group A	Wed, August 5 Grades 9-12 Group A	Thurs, August 6 9th grade only Group B	Fri, August 7 Grades 9-12 Group B
Mon, August 10 Group A	Tues, August 11 Group A	Wed, August 12 (no students, school planning)	Thurs, August 13 Group B	Fri, August 14 Group B

School will fall into the planned rotation for the rest of the year beginning the week of August 17 with Group A Mon/Tues and Group B Thurs/Fri.

Students will also be screened daily upon arrival. High school drop off will be in the bus parking lot. Cars will be asked to circle the bus lot and drop students off in front of a tent/table mauka of the band room. After exiting the vehicle, students will be temperature checked and screened there before being allowed to enter the main campus. For students that drive to campus, parking stalls will be assigned and once they arrive, they will be required to approach the same tent/table for screening. Please know visitors and staff are also required to be screened. We apologize for the inconvenience, but the health and safety of our community is of utmost importance.

We would like to remind everyone that the best screening is the one we do at home. It is the first line of defense for everyone. If your child exhibits any of the following symptoms, please keep him or her home until they are symptom-free. Please screen your child daily for the following symptoms before sending or bringing him/her to school:

Feverish
Coughing and/or Sneezing
Sore Throat
Shortness of Breath
Headache, Stomachache, or Nausea
Muscle Pain
New Loss of Taste or Smell

Our pickup procedure has been modified as well. For parents picking up their children, parking and pickup will be in the mauka half of the student parking lot (the lot below the gym). The bus parking lot will be used exclusively for busses and bus riders.

These two weeks of half-days will be used to assess procedures and plan so we can possibly bring back more students daily and identify those that may need extra support.

All students must bring their own cloth mask every day. Also, don't forget to bring a pair of earbuds and your own laptop/chromebook if you have one.

Thank you everyone for your patience and flexibility. The first two weeks will be used to assess procedures and reassess plans. Again, the goal is to try and bring back as many students face-to-face as safety permits. Please remember, now is a good time to start practicing with masks for longer periods of time!
