Drop-off and Pick-up

For those that are dropping off and picking up students, thank you for bearing with the traffic. With limited bus service this year we completely understand there will be more cars on the road in and around all area schools.

Drop-off for Konawaena High School is in the bus parking lot.

Pick-up for Konawaena High School is in the parking lot below (makai) the gym. If you arrive ahead of time you may park in that parking lot to wait, please do not exit your vehicle.

Student Schedules

Students that have an incomplete schedule or no schedule at all should see the appropriate counselor to get their schedule filled.

For students that want to change their schedules, changes will not be made until the start of next week (August 10). Students are expected to attend all classes in their current schedule until then.

Students that have been enrolled in our full Distance Learning Option, the Edmentum program will be used. Those schedules and course access will be confirmed next week. The expected start date should be during the week of the 16th but it may happen earlier, please be on the lookout for emails. Parents that are still considering the full online option, please complete the Distance Learning Option contract by Friday, August 13 so final adjustments can be made to rosters.

Athletics

The DOE has postponed the opening of the fall sports season for all public schools until September 24 and is requiring student athletes, coaches, athletic volunteers, and other athletic personnel to be fully COVID vaccinated. There are no practices and/or games until then. The Pfizer vaccination is currently the one approved for 12 and older and is a two shot cycle for full vaccination. In order to be eligible to play by September 24 the first shot must be received by August 20. The second shot is scheduled for three weeks later, then there is a two week wait period for the body to build full immunity (that's why September 24). Please arrange for students to get their shots ASAP. For students and coaches of Winter and Spring sports, now is the time to vaccinate in preparation for the season.

Lockers and Dues

Lockers may be paid for at the business office at any time. School and class dues and fees may also be paid throughout the year at the main office business office window.
