 - a. Comprehensive Needs Assessment - To identify what we need in our Academic Plan. Example: attendance, student grades, students with SEL and trauma informed (9th grade retention at one time was at 7% then through the pandemic, this year is at 20%.

 - c. Student Activities – With change in mask mandate, students on campus currently have to wear masks indoors and outdoors is optional. Activities continue in a limited fashion because we are still in a pandemic. Momi will approve certain things to happen with some guidance and protocols set in place. Activities in the fourth quarter will be for just students, no outside guests thus minimizing people on campus. Randi presented the following activities forthcoming:
 - i. Juniors doing SBAC during the next 3 weeks
 - ii. Senior Prom at Outrigger Kona Resort and Spa on Saturday, April 9 (modified for Konawaena students only).
 - iii. Homecoming Week on April 25 (modified). It is usually held in fall semester but this year in April. Activities include honoring students in different sports, traditional run/walk, powder puff.
 - iv. May Day on May 6 (modified) and also a virtual event.
 - v. AP Exams (early college), first 2 weeks in May
 - vi. Graduation on May 21 (DOE guidelines to follow)
 - vii. Upcoming senior/parent meeting for more information next Wednesday, April 6 (state memo from DOE about graduation guidelines can found on DOE website)

- viii. Kats Council meeting held yesterday, introducing incoming class officers for next school year including KSG, freshmen and juniors (vacancies for class officer positions available). Student concerns were discussed and it has been a transitional year. Council was tasked with solutions in next meeting in April.
