At Konawaena High School, we take pride in providing our students with memorable and enriching experiences, and Winter Ball is no exception. To maintain a positive and respectful atmosphere during the event, we have established certain guidelines and behavior expectations that all attendees must adhere to.

Winter Ball Requirements:

Behavior Expectations: Students are not allowed to have **two** Class C or D offenses or **one** Class A or B offense on their disciplinary record *during the second quarter*. We believe in fostering a safe and respectful environment, and these offenses are indicative of behaviors that are not in alignment with our school's values.

Class C or D Offenses: These include offenses such as contraband possession, smoking, truancy, class cutting, abusive language, and cell phone violations.

Class A and B Offenses: These involve more serious misconduct like gambling, theft, harassment, fighting, bullying, drugs and alcohol use or possession and assault.

Guest Responsibility: Students are responsible for the behavior of their guests. If a guest's behavior violates our school rules and regulations, both the student and the guest may face consequences.

Please be aware that no refunds will be given to students or guests if a student is not allowed to attend the Winter Ball due to behavior consequences.

If you have any concerns or questions regarding these requirements or any other aspect of the Winter Ball, please do not hesitate to contact us. We are here to support our students and ensure a memorable and responsible event for all.
